The first meeting of this new series is set to take place on 20-21 November 2025. Alongside the main scientific programme covering speakers from academia, government and industry, this meeting will combine:

- Two keynote speakers
- Panel discussions with invited guests
- Networking sessions with industry professionals
- Poster presentations
- A student competition

The meeting will appeal to both academic researchers and those working in industry, with the aim to foster stronger networks and new collaborations between the two branches of the Engineering Geology community; with a particular focus on supporting early-career members of this community.
