We are delighted to announce that we have re-launched our <u>Picture Library</u> of historic images on a brand new platform with a print-on-demand service.



Logging the Chalk by Rory Mortimore has been added to the Library's e-book collection, free for Fellows.



VIEW THE MAP RECORD

From the Map Room - Structural map of the Atlantic Ocean

The Library has recently acquired several maps from the Commission for the Geological Map of the World including the <u>1:20,000,000 Structural map</u> of the Atlantic Ocean, published in 2012. It comes as a large flat sheet along with a small explanatory text and shows the Mid-Atlantic ridge and associated sea-floor spreading and magnetic anomalies.


